

STUDENT GOVERNMENT GUIDELINES

Purpose:

Class-elected officers work in conjunction with Student Council and are expected to be active members of Student Council. Student Council does not have elected officers.

The purpose of Student Council is to share responsibilities in assisting classes with fund raisers and community service projects and to promote school spirit and uphold school rules. Student Council is also in charge of Homecoming Week festivities.

Sponsors:

Student Council has two teacher sponsors and class officers have one teacher sponsor for each class. Ideas should be presented at Student Council meetings for majority rule. Students should not seek out meetings with individuals acting alone. Students should only act on approved ideas from the Student Council and with approval from their Class Sponsor or Student Council Sponsor.

Meetings:

There are 2 Student Council meetings each month. The Student Council sponsors will run the meetings with time set aside for each class president to present any news pertaining to his or her class.

Each year, each board of class officers will be in charge of one fundraiser with proceeds going to that class and one community service project. Other Student Council members from all classes will be expected to help out.
